# TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE GRANT GUIDELINES

*The NYSCA State and Local Partnerships (SLP) Division has made available a discrete pot of funds through the Technical Assistance Program to its constituent Decentralization (DEC) Sites and State & Local Partnership organizations statewide. All requests will be reviewed for eligibility and available on a first come, first serve basis.*

**Who May Apply:** FY2020 State & Local Partnership Grantee Organizations ONLY

**Award Amount:** \$500 per organization\*

\*DEC Sites are eligible to receive an additional \$100 if they participate in the two Leveraging Technology Programs.\*\*

**Project Period:** November 1, 2020 to October 31, 2021

## ABOUT THE PROGRAM

Technology grants are available (maximum of \$600 for DEC Sites\*\* and \$500 for NYSCA SLP organizations) for equipment, training, and/or resources to address the technical needs of organizations impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic. We anticipate between 53 and 58 grants to be awarded across New York State on a first come, first serve basis. Ineligible applicants will be notified within 3 business days.

\*\*DEC Sites may request \$600 in total if they participate in both Leveraging Technology Sessions presented by NYSCA. These programs include Virtual Public Engagement on 9/16/2020 and the Virtual Panel Session on 10/14/2020.

## PROGRAM PRIORITIES:

All NYSCA State & Local Partnership Grantees in 2020 are eligible to apply. Priority will be given to Decentralization Sites.

## HOW TO APPLY

All applicants should submit their materials through [Submittable](#). A complete application must contain the following materials:

1. **Applicant Profile:** includes basic questions such as organizational information and authorized signer information.
2. **Project Information:** Selected technology expenses and explanation, request amount, and total project cost.

## ELIGIBLE EXPENSES\*\*\*

Grants may fund the following:

- Purchase of equipment and/or equipment upgrades (lights, mics, backgrounds, etc.)
- Licenses and subscriptions for virtual and digital platforms and software
- Professional Fees for artists or consultants/contractors to create content

\*\*\*Please note receipts for all grant-funded purchases will be required to be submitted with the final report.
